## **Travel Grant applications and Abstract submission**

Up to 20 Travel Grants will be awarded to presenters of the best Abstracts for oral or poster presentations submitted before 31 May 2009. Travel costs of up to £200 sterling will be repaid to successful applicants on production of relevant receipts after the meeting.

Free course fees (registration and accommodation) will also be provided for the presenters of the best eight abstracts selected for oral presentation. Successful presenters will be notified after the Abstract judging in the first week of June and their Course fees will be reimbursed on registration at the meeting.

Travel grants will only be available for delegates who submit an abstract for the meeting. The abstracts should be no longer than 250 words, starting with a short title followed by the names and institutions of the authors with the name of the lead presenter underlined. The text of the abstract should be structured under the following headings: Background, Objectives/aims, Methods, Results and Conclusions.

Authors should specify whether they would like the Abstract considered for Poster presentation, Free Communication (oral) or both.
