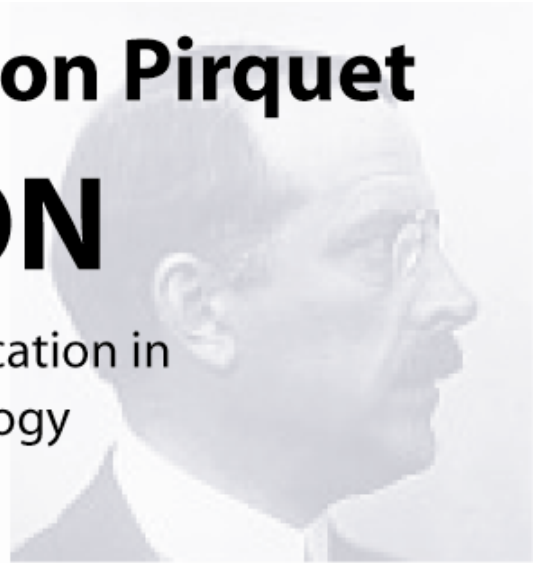

Third annual report of the EAACI Clemens von Pirquet Foundation

We have the pleasure to provide you the third annual report of the Foundation since its launch in 2007. The Foundation has been set up to promote Education and Research in Pediatric allergy, in close collaboration with EAACI Section on Pediatrics. 2009 has been busy with both education and especially research activities which will be outlined in the following pages.

In 2009, our bank account and assets have been transferred from the Dresdner Bank in Berlin to the Credit Suisse in Geneva. Partial recovery from the financial crisis during 2009 and the strong Swiss franc allowed a partial recovery from our previous financial losses. In addition, conservative investments on the long term should secure our assets and provide the Foundation with a secure financial situation.

This year again, we would like to thank all active partners in our Research and Education projects, in particular the EAACI-SP board and members who have been most supportive in our activities.

We hope that this annual report will be of interest to the community of European pediatric allergists and we are looking forward for a very fruitful 2010.

iPAC is running for FP7 Research Funding

iPAC, the International Pediatric Allergy Research Consortium was founded in 2007, after a very fruitful brainstorming meeting in Portugal. Key pediatric allergists from Europe and around the world constitute the core of iPAC. Together with EuroPrevall, iPAC was running in 2009 for a health call under the Framework Program 7 of the European Union Commission.

The specific call iPAC was involved in included excellent projects and our proposal proudly obtained a very good score, but unfortunately was ranked only 3rd, without real chances of funding. This project was for iPAC a very good opportunity to gain some experience in running for competitive funding. This experience will be used for further calls within EU framework programs or other research funding programs.



Certification of Pediatric allergy training centers

During 2009, the Education and Training committee for European pediatric allergy has been active in promoting education in the specialty and by starting accreditation of Austrian pediatric allergists. Promotion is made for other countries to apply for the diploma of pediatric allergists, as well as for centers to apply for the certification for training.
